What is the Mini-Masters? **This is our Junior Open for *younger, less experienced or higher handicap junior golfers.***

The competition will be held in the October half-term and will be played over holes 3-11 on the Manor Course. The first 2 holes will be played as 'practice' to enable our visiting juniors to 'warm-up' and will also include a Nearest the Line competition on the 1st hole.

The Mini-Masters is a '9-hole' competition played from our Blue Tees (ca. 2000 yard course for U8 & U10) or from our Red Tees (ca. 2600 yard course for U12). These tees are rated for official handicaps. Parents/guardians are welcome and are actively encouraged to support their child during their round.

Players will compete for Age Category prizes, nearest the pin and straightest drive prizes.
